## Before hiring an attorney to assist you in probate:

	Allow yourself the time to plan a funeral and be with family
	Determine if there is a Will
	If there is no will found, discuss with family who should be the person to act on behalf of the estate as the personal representative.
	Gather important financial documents such as the most recent bank statements and investment statements
	Gather any evidence of debt
	Gather any documents regarding the homestead or other real property
	Gather monthly bills
You should not:	
	Continue to use a Power of Attorney, if you were so-named; a Power of Attorney ends at death
	Give away any personal property, even if it's in the Will
	Transfer title on any vehicles
	Place real property on the market for sale
	Pay any bills and debts. We first must determine wether the estate has enough assets to pay them in full
